- -- Motion to approve 04-07-2022 Water Committee Meeting Minutes by Larry L., 2nd by Jay
 - -- Motion to amend to correct the AutoCAD reference to indicate that Horizons will provide both AutoCAD <u>and</u> GIS versions, and to correct the spelling of the company name DuBois & King By Larry L., 2nd Jay
 - Amendment approved 4-0
 - -- Motion to approve the Minutes as Amended. Approved 4-0
- -- CC: -- Horizons is developing the Hydro Model in AutoCAD
 - -- Data will be transferred to VDOE as GIS
- -- LL Need to publicize the 5/7 Public Meeting
- -- CC -- Has done public presentations with Luis Adorno
 - -- Will explain the AM program to the audience
 - -- Will explain the goals and invite discussion
 - -- Primary focus of the meeting will be on Level of Service
- -- JB -- Should have Water Consumer Confidence Reports available at the meeting
 - -- Some possible LOS goals:
 - -- What should we test for and what level should be the goal?
 - -- Water main break: send eBlast; expected time to recovery;

Tasks homeowner should do for discoloration, grit/sand, air bubbles

- -- CC -- Should develop a FAQ
 - -- How to report a leak
 - -- What to do if homeowner sees a drop in pressure in their house Clean the screen in their backflow protector, etc.
 - -- What to do if: discoloration, grit/sand, air bubbles
- -- LL -- A while ago, collected information from homeowners re:
 - -- Pressure reducing valves
 - -- Backflow preventers
- -- CC -- Maybe should add these two items as goals
- -- JB -- Typical water bill of \$400 was increased to \$450 this year to begin to build capital reserve
- -- LS -- Commissioners said the Capital Budget in the early Draft/Template is unaffordable & unattainable
- -- CC -- That schedule is just a starting point for discussion
- -- LL -- We need to take a new look at leak detection equipment
 - -- There are now Grants available for leak detection work
 - -- Need flow detection in & out at each pump station is SCADA reporting this?

- -- CC -- That pump station flow detection may be the best option for leak detection other than installing meters
- -- LL -- Looked into installing meters way too expensive
- -- LS -- Meters would still have to have a basic distribution charge that applied to all customers since usage fees won't cover expenses
- -- LL -- Will not be at the 5/7 Public Presentation
 - -- Motion to appoint JB as the Chair for the 5/7 meeting in LL's absence Made by LL, 2nd by Doug Approved 4-0
- -- JB -- Agenda for 5/7?
- -- CC -- JB: Introductions

- -- LS -- Do need to review the project status
 - -- Discuss tools to help improve the system
- -- LL -- 2005 Master Plan goals, Capital Improvement Plan, etc.
 - -- Some done
 - -- Some no longer needed
 - -- Some still valid be sure they are rolled into the current plan
- -- JB -- NickSceggell's update of his model:
 - -- Has added Reinach tank, lines, zone; Oak Ridge Rd water line
 - -- Still missing some line extensions, the number of new homes added
 - -- Completed this update and sent exported data to Horizons last Friday
- -- JB -- Once the Horizons model is implemented, will no longer need or use Nick / Debois & King
 - -- Debois & King does not have any AM experience
- -- CC -- The GIS Model can make it easy to report work done on the system
- -- DP -- For the 5/7 meeting, he will draft an Agenda
- -- CC -- We will need to have a Final Public Meeting for presentation of the completed project & report
 - -- Luis Adorno does like to attend these meetings
 - -- DES will probably allow this to be scheduled after the project deadline (the project is complete just presenting it to the public)
- -- JB -- This does not require 30 days notice since it is a presentation with no voting
