Article 02 Purchase of a new Truck

To see if the village district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$310,000 (gross budget) for the a new DPW truck, also authorize a withdrawal from the Highway Capitol Reserve in the amount of \$70,000 and to authorize the issuance of not more than \$240,000 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) and to authorize the municipal officials to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon; and to further appropriate \$22,300 for the first year payment. Funds for this appropriation will be raised by taxation.

Article 03 Purchase of a new Truck

To see if the village district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$180,000 (gross budget) for the purchase of a new truck, and to authorize the issuance of not more than \$180,000 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) and to authorize the municipal officials to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon; further to appropriate \$16,700 for the first years payment. Funding for this appropriation will be raised by taxation.

Article 04 Operations Budget

To see if the village district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$833,730 for general municipal operations. This article does not include appropriations contained in special or individual articles addressed separately. Funding for this appropriation will be raised by taxation.

Article 05 Water Budget

To see if the Village District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$257,046 for the purpose of the Water Budget. This special article is a special warrant article per RSA 32:3 VI (d) and RSA 32:7 V. The GOVERNING BODY recommend this appropriation. This appropriation is to be funded by water user fees.
